


















USA Chapter Second Annual Alumni Meet 2018

SREC prof finds a new way to recycle aluminum scrap

Dr C. Bhagyanathan, pro-fessor of Mechanical Ramakrishna Engineering College (SREC) reported that the existing technology to recycle aluminum scrap into graded quality aluminum ingots in batches not only involves the deployment of huge manual laborers for sorting of the scraps but also requires exclusive high capacity furnace for producing the graded ingots at huge
