# Prof.P.R.Ramaswami

Former Principal – Government College of Technology, Coimbatore Former Managing Trustee – SNR Sons Charitable Trust

Prof.P.R.Ramaswami was born on 1st November, 1915. He did his "Intermediate" at the Government Arts College, Coimbatore, and his undergraduate degree in science in the Presidency College, Madras. Seeing his proficiency in studies, his father sent him to do the BE (Construction Engineering) at Manchester University, United Kingdom. After World War II, on graduation, he joined the Floating Dock construction section of Port Trust at UK and worked for 3 years and returned to India in 1944.

He started a company named "Allround Construction Company" in 1944 and got a government contract in 1945 to lay the cement concrete road from Coimbatore to Mettupalayam for a stretch of about 40 Kms. He strictly and meticulously followed all the specifications and a splendid job was done. The road is laid to perfection with curves and super elevations which made travel a pleasure. This cement concrete road project was a test of his integrity.

He started his teaching career as Professor of Civil Engineering in the Government College of Technology in 1947, which assignment, he had taken in an honorary capacity and later he got elevated as the Principal of the same institution.

He endeared himself to the students, being loving, kind, very talented, gifted, easily approachable yet he was a strict disciplinarian. With his global exposure in academic curriculum, he suggested to the University of Madras the implementation of Semester System. During his tenure as Principal, there were tremendous expansions in buildings for the college and the hostel.

Prof.P.R.Ramaswami fondly known as Prof.PRR, was an icon amongst the pedagogues, he was illusionary and a shining star in the college galaxy, in short a perfect gentleman and a best teacher.



# Prof.Anil.D.Sahasrabudhe

Prof. Anil D. Sahasrabudhe graduated from BVB College of Engineering and Technology, Hubli affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad, Karnataka in Mechanical Engineering with First Rank and Gold medal in 1980. Subsequently, he obtained Master's and Doctoral (with UGC Fellowship) degrees from Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore in 1982 and 1989 respectively.

Prof. Anil D. Sahasrabudhe in his illustrious career of 31 years held several important Academic, Research and Administrative positions. He started his career as Scientific Officer, at Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 1983 and moved to Tata Consulting Engineers (TCE) as Engineer in the same year. He served as Lecturer and Assistant Professor at North Eastern Regional Institute of Science and Technology (NERIST), Itanagar (Arunachal Pradesh) from 1987-1988 & again from 1989-1995, before joining IIT Guwahati as Associate Professor in 1995 and has been serving as Professor since 1999. Also, he served as Director, College of Engineering, Pune (CoEP) since 2006 on deputation from IIT, Guwahati prior to joining as AICTE Chairman. As an Academician and Researcher in NERIST and IIT Guwahati, and as an Administrator in the capacity of Director, CoEP, he has taken up several new initiatives for Academic, Curricular & Co-curricular activities, Entrepreneurship, Research and Good Governance.

Prof. Anil D. Sahasrabudhe is presently working as Chairman & Expert Member on various National Level Committees. Some of these include; Chairman, Basic Scientific Research (BSR), Empowered Committee of UGC, SWAYAM Board and Chairman BOG of NIT Itanagar. As a Member/Fellow he is actively involved in the activities of many Professional Bodies/Societies, such as ISTE, ASME, ASEE, ASI, IET, Institution of Engineers(IE).

He was awarded with "Maha-Intrapreneur Award-2011" of Praj Industries, Pune for his Leadership and Innovative abilities in the area of Technology Development & Entrepreneurship initiatives and "Edupreneur Award-2013" from Engineering Watch.

Presently, Prof. Anil Dattatraya Sahasrabudhe is the Chairman of All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi.
